When you think of wine in the United States, what is the first place that pops into your head? I would bet the farm, that nine times out of ten Napa Valley, California would be the first place that comes to your mind. Well, let me tell you about a place known as the Yadkin Valley.

First Stop: Thistle Meadow Winery

Just a short 30 minute drive south from Blue Ridge Estates you will find Thistle Meadow Winery. A winery is not to be confused with a vineyard, it is a place where wine grapes are purchased from growers (vineyards) and are processed to make wines. The Thistle Meadow Winery is housed in what looks like a big red barn. Attached to the winery and tasting room is another establishment called grapestompers. Here you can purchase all your essentials for making your very own wine at home. Also, on the property is an old farm house that has been converted into a bed and breakfast. Thistle Meadow Winery is family owned, so don't be surprised if you find yourself discussing wine with one of the owners. 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Second Stop:

Round Peak Vineyards

Third Stop:

THE WOLF'S LAIR

Wolf's Lair is just a quick 40 minute drive from Blue Ridge Estates. Passing through the gates of Black Wolf Vineyard, you find yourself driving through the actual vineyard with rows and rows of vines. Wolf's Lair is open to all that want to enjoy great wine, delicious food and live entertainment. The Wolf's Lair restaurant hosts an incredible menu and has a very intimate wine tasting room.
